NEW CLUBHOUSE FOR COLLEGE PINES GOLF CLUB IN NOTTINGHAMSHIRE

A functional clubhouse was required by a new golf course to blend in with the local countryside.

The Problem

David Snell, one of the country's leading golf professionals, had recently developed an 18 hole championship golf course adjacent to Welbeck College near Worksop, Nottinghamshire. Pinelog were approached to design and build a clubhouse which would complement the surrounding forestry and provide various facilities.

The Solution

The 165 sq m club house was designed in pine to complement the surrounding countryside. 18.3m long x 9m wide, the building incorporates showers and WC's, kitchen and store room, as well as a professional shop and general purpose reception area.

The building uses a standard 50 mm log construction with Thermalog insulation and internal pine panelling finish to provide a sandwich walling detail. All windows are double glazed and the roof is also insulated.

The verandah and carpeting throughout the interior provide the finishing touches to the building, which was completed in just 10 weeks.

The Benefits

A complete turn-key operation, the building was designed and built to provide a superb clubhouse at this new golf course. The accommodation provides a relatively inexpensive and infinitely flexible solution to a golf club or other type of sports club wishing to develop its facilities.
